One of the joys of preparing an annual report is that it gives us a chance to look back and to be thankful for all that has been accomplished. The past year was filled with both opportunities and challenges. Some highlights were:

- Assisted 346 adults and 196 children in need in Teller County
- Our volunteers gave 4,578 hours of their time to Help the Needy
- We distributed \$92,929 in assistance to our clients in need.
- We successfully held two events which provided funds for our mission the annual Sweetheart Ball and the Cruise Above the Clouds Car Show. Together these events provided over \$42,000 in much needed funds.
